ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

The University of Mysore welcomes you to its picturesque campuses head quartered in the heart of Mysore city. It was established on July 27, 1916. It is the sixth oldest University in the country and the first in the state of Karnataka. Also, in a sense it is the first University of the country to be established outside the limits of the British India. The University was founded as a result of the efforts of the benevolent and visionary Maharaja of erstwhile Princely State of Mysore His Highness Shri Nalvadi Krishnaraja Wadiyar IV (1884-1940), and the then Diwan Sir M. Visvesvaraya (1860-1962). The University was granted autonomy in the year 1956. Originally the territorial jurisdiction of the University consisted of nine districts of Karnataka state. With the creation of Bangalore University in 1964, Mangalore University in 1980, Kuvempu University in 1987, Karnataka State Open University in 1996, Mandya University in 2022, Hassan University in 2022 and Chamarajanagara University in 2022, the territorial jurisdiction of the University of Mysore is now confined to Mysuru District.

It is the first University to be accredited by NAAC in the year 2000 with Five Star Status and the University is re - accredited for the 4th time in 2021 with an 'A' Grade. In the India Rankings - 2023 conducted by NIRF, University of Mysore has secured 44th rank in the 'University Category' and 71st in the 'Overall Category'.

The University is located in Mysuru, the cultural centre of Karnataka. Mysuru was the capital of the princely state. It is a city of palaces, temples, and gardens. Being a splendid tourist centre with historical monuments and unique architecture, it is famous for silk, sandalwood oil and artifacts of ivory and sandalwood. The city has salubrious climate through out the year. It is about 140 kms south west of Bengaluru, the state capital, and is well connected by rail, road and air.

MOTTO

The motto of the University is well engraved on its emblem: (depicting the bird 'Gandabherunda' flanked on either side by lion-elephant Sharaba - a mythical creature believed to be stronger than the lion and the elephant and the upholder of righteousness) that "Nothing Equals Knowledge" ("Na hi Jnanena Sadrisham" - an excerpt from Bhagavad Gita) and "I will Always Uphold the Truth" (Satyamevoddaharamuaham). Thus the

greatness of knowledge and the commitment to adhere to truth are the ideals, the University is pursuing all through its existence, and in its path of success.

CAMPUS

The main campus named 'Manasagangotri' - eternal flow of the mind - by the Poet-laureate 'Kuvempu', the former Vice-Chancellor, and the first 'Jnanapeetha' awardee, is located on 739 acres of picturesque land along with sprawling Kukkarahalli lake surrounded by verdurous trees extending to an area of 261 acres. The campus has a good number of well maintained gardens and lawns. The ambience is comparable to some of the world-class universities having pleasant weather, noise-free environment and student-friendly atmosphere. The University School of Engineering has been the most recent inclusion to our wonderful campus.

There are 52 PG Departments in the University of Mysore offering 146 Programs of which 126 are Postgraduate Programs. There are 4 Constituent Colleges and 104 Affiliated Colleges. The total strength of the students in UG, PG and Ph.D. Programs is over one lakh. We have 40 Specialized Programs, 44 Recognized Research Centers, 9 Training Centers, 3 Foreign Collaborations and 24 National Collaborations. Further, there are 11 PG Departments with National Research Facilities and 13 Chairs. Enrollment of a large number of overseas students from around 51 countries reflects the international reputation of the University.

103rd INDIAN SCIENCE CONGRESS - 2016

University of Mysore and The Indian Science Congress Association successfully organized the 103rd Science Congress during January 03 to 07, 2016. The focal theme of the congress was 'Science and Technology for Indigenous Development in India'. It was inaugurated on January 3, 2016 by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India Shri Narendra Modi.

There were 18,528 delegates registered for the conference. Around 600 delegates from foreign countries namely USA, Canada, UK, Australia, Japan, Korea, France etc, participated in the congress. Six Nobel Laureates, one Field Medalist, one Bharatha Rathna Awardee and many eminent scientists of national and international repute have delivered lectures during the congress. There were totally 28 plenary sessions, 25 symposia and 18 technical sessions pertaining to different disciplines of Science and Technology. Parallelly, Women Science Congress, Science Communicators' Meet and Children Science Congress

were also organized.





INDIAN SOCIAL SCIENCE CONGRESS - 2016

The Indian Academy of Social Sciences (IASS) in association with the University of Mysore, also organized the 40th Session of Indian Social Science Congress from 19th, 23rd December 2016 with the focal theme 'People's Health and Quality of Life in India'. The president of IASS, Allahabad

Prof. B.M.Hegde inaugurated the congress. Almost all the chairpersons and conveners of 28 research committees and 21thematic panels took part in this event. More than 5000 social scientists and delegates participated in the deliberations of the congress.

CENTRAL INSTRUMENTATION FACILITY AT VIJNANA BHAVANA

The Vijnana Bhavana is a central instrumentation facility of the University of Mysore that steers major projects such as Institution of Excellence (IOE), University with Potential for Excellence (UPE), Centre with Potential for Excellence in a Particular Area (CPEPA) and Department of Science and Technology- Promotion of University Research and Scientific Excellence (DST-PURSE). As a prime productive research centre it houses core instrumentation facility such as NMR, NGS, LCMS, XRD, XRF, SEM and Animal Cell Culture facility.

INSTITUTION OF EXCELLENCE (IOE)

The University of Mysore was identified as an 'Institution of Excellence' by the Government of India in 2008 to create a 'Centre of Excellence' in multi disciplinary research activities and foster overall development of the University. A grant of Rs.100 crore by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India elevated the University to the status of Institution of Excellence in the thrust area of Bio-diversity, Bio-prospecting and Sustainable Development. IOE program is a multi disciplinary in



nature involving expertise from disciplines such as Anthropology, Biochemistry, Biotechnology, Botany, Chemistry, Earth Science, Economics, Microbiology, Molecular Biology, Physics, Zoology, Sericulture, Political Science and Sociology.

UNIVERSITY WITH POTENTIAL FOR EXCELLENCE (UPE)

The University of Mysore has a long established tradition to carry out interdisciplinary and trans-border research involving several departments. The University Grants Commission (UGC) had sanctioned Rs.50 crore considering the University of Mysore as University with Potential for Excellence (UPE) in 2012, for a period of five years and extended it for one more year.

CENTRE WITH POTENTIAL FOR EXCELLENCE IN A PARTICULAR AREA (CPEPA)

The University had received 9.5 crore from UGC under the banner 'Centre with Potential for Excellence in a Particular Area' (CPEPA) for an interdisciplinary program involving selected science departments to work on Nano-science and Nano-technology.

PROMOTION OF UNIVERSITY RESEARCH AND SCIENTIFIC EXCELLENCE (PURSE)

The University was been identified as one of the top 20 Universities in scientific publications and was awarded 9 crore under DST-PURSE Scheme, and renewed for 2nd Phase in 2016 with an award of 8.5 crore. DST-PURSE project includes two major components: 'Strengthening capabilities and supporting networks by building physical infrastructure and creating an ambience for academic ecology' and 'Development of molecules and materials for sustainable technology'. The facilities established under DST-PURSE houses analytical and preparative HPLC, Gel permeation Chromatography, Mass Spectrometry, Cell Sorters, Flow Cytometry, Gel-Doc, UV-visible, Spectrophotometer etc.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

The University of Mysore is offering Postgraduate, Graduate, Diploma and Certificate programs. There are six faculties, viz., (1) Arts, (2) Science and Technology, (3) Commerce, (4) Education, (5) Law, (6) Engineering.

The distinct strength of the University lies in providing quality education with focus on Fine Arts, Humanities, Languages, Law, Physical Education, Pure and Applied Sciences, Education and Social Sciences. Most of the postgraduate departments are of international repute and known for excellence in research. Research projects worth of crores of rupees have been sanctioned to various University departments by national and international institutions and funding agencies.

The Department of Science and Technology (DST) of the Government of India had recognized the Departments of Botany, Biochemistry, Biotechnology, Chemistry, Earth Science, Microbiology, Physics, Sericulture, Statistics and Zoology under FIST program.

The University Grants Commission (UGC) had recognized the Departments of Bio-Chemistry, Biotechnology, Chemistry, Commerce, Computer Science, Earth Science, Food Science and Nutrition, Journalism and Mass Communication, Library and Information Science, Mathematics, Physics, Political Science, Statistics, Zoology and Kuvempu Institute of Kannada Studies under the Special Assistance Program (SAP).

CHOICE-BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (CBCS)

The Choice Based Credit System provides flexibility in designing curriculum and follows a 'Cafeteria' type approach in which the students can take courses of their choice, learn at their own pace, undergo additional courses and acquire more than the required credits and adopt an interdisciplinary approach to learning. Currently 76 programs are being offered under CBCS.

Fexible Choice- Based Credit System with Continuous Assessment Grading Pattern (FCBCS-CAGP)

In an effort to move towards the complete version of the CBCS-CAGP scheme as emphasized by the UGC and to provide greater autonomy, the University has permitted the following departments to run the programs under Flexible CBCS-CAGP from 2017-18.

This Policy proposes the revision and revamping of all aspects of the education structure, including its regulation and governance, to create a new system that is aligned with the aspirational goals of 21st century education, including SDG4, while building upon India's traditions and value systems.

The University of Mysore has introduced NEP at the Graduate level from the academic year 2021-22. It is contemplating to introduce NEP at the Postgraduate level in the due course.

The University of Mysore has implemented UGC-MOOCs SWAYAM Courses from the year 2018-19 at the postgraduate level. ORIENTAL RESEARCH INSTITUTE (ORI)

ORI is housed in the architecturally attractive jubilee hall built in 1887 to commemorate the golden jublee of Queen Victoria's accession to the British throne. The Institute has a

collection of over 30,000 rare palm leaf manuscripts and paper manuscripts and a collection of more than 70,000 works in Sanskrit and Kannada.

CENTRE FOR INFORMATION SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (CIST)

The University of Mysore has been in the forefront in extending non-formal education in Information Technology through CIST, housed in the imposing Senate Hall complex at Manasagangotri. This is an ISO 9001-2000 Certified Centre. Students on the campus may acquire and upgrade their computer skills concurrently with their regular academic programs, through non-formal training programs offered by CIST and thus equip themselves to face the challenges of the modern world.

EDUCATIONAL MULTI-MEDIA RESEARCH CENTRE (EMRC)

EMRC is the only institution of its kind established by the UGC in the entire state of Karnataka which produces educational videos for 24-hour educational television channel and Doordarshan's National Network DD-1. It has bagged two National Awards and 'Best Video Program' under Senior Secondary category at the 22nd All India Children's Educational Audio-Video Festival and ICT Mela 2018. It also won special jury award in the 8th National Science Film Festival - 2018

SCHOOL OF PLANNING AND ARCHITECTURE (SPA)

School of Planning and Architecture (SPA) was established in the year 2002 in the sylvan surroundings of Manasagangotri campus. The school develops young talents in the profession of Architecture and Planning. M.Tech.in Urban and Regional Planning (M.Tech. in URP), a program offered under Institute of Development Studies was integrated into program in Planning and Architecture. The school currently has around 400 students.

The school is equipped with the state of the art infrastructure in the form of studios, class rooms with audio visual facility, library, laboratories and stationary shop. The School offers programs recognized by the Council of Architecture, Government of India.



MYSORE UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING (MUSE)

Mysore University School of Engineering is affiliated to the University of Mysore and is approved by AICTE, New Delhi. It started functioning from the academic year 2021-2022. The college offers five B.E courses namely, Artificial Intelligence and Data Science, Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning, Biomedical and Robotic Engineering, Civil Environmental Engineering and Computer Science and Design Engineering branches which are challenging and up-to-date with modern practices and techniques that will enable the students to succeed upon graduation.

UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF FOREIGN LANGUAGES (USOFL)

The University School of Foreign Languages is one of the oldest foreign languages departments in India. The University School of Foreign Languages was established in March 1972 and was attached to DoS in English. Subsequently, the University School of Foreign Languages acquired autonomy and independent status in March 1977. It offers four levels of part-time courses in seven major foreign languages which can be completed within two years. This School caters to the students interest in pursuing higher studies abroad, as well as gives them an opportunity of learn foreign languages while pursing their degree. The Department also plans to offer exclusive short-term courses for students pursing other full time degree courses.

SCHOOL OF LAW

The University of Mysore established the School of Law in 2006. This School introduced 5-Year B.A. LL.B. and B.Com LLB integrated programs in 2007. The programs were offered as a part of the self-financed scheme with the approval of the Government of Karnataka and the recognition of the Bar Council of India, New Delhi. The School of Law is imparting quality legal education and preparing the present generation to build a society that inculcates equality, human dignity and public consciousness among students. The School intends to produce quality Advocates and Legal Officers in the society.

ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICES

The Crawford Hall houses the offices of the Vice-Chancellor, the Registrar, the Registrar (Evaluation) and the Finance Officer of the University. The Office of the Administrative Officer situated at Senate Bhavana, Manasagangotri looks after the campus

administration. The office oversees admission, examination, scholarship and support facilities of the PG students of the Manasagangotri Campus.

AUTHORITIES OF THE UNIVERSITY

The Authorities of the University are the Syndicate, the Academic Council, the Finance Committee, the Planning, Monitoring and Evaluation Board, the six Faculties and the Board of Studies. The University is governed by the Karnataka State Universities' Act, 2000.

INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC)

IQAC is an important administrative body that is responsible for quality initiatives in the institution. The prime responsibility of IQAC is to plan, supervise and implement various activities to impart quality education. IQAC facilitates the creation of a learner-centric environment and arranges for feedback collection rom all the stakeholders on quality related institutional processes.

SUPPORT SERVICES

Auditoria

Facilities to promote co-curricular activities exist in the University. There are ten auditoria-one each at the Crawford Hall, Vijnana Bhavana, Dr. B.R.Ambedkar Research and Extension Centre, Maharaja's College Centenary Building, the University College of Fine Arts, Humanities Block, Bahadur Institute of Management Sciences, Educational Multi-Media Research Centre, Kuvempu Institute of Kannada Studies and Senate Bhavana. In addition, most of the departments have well-furnished seminar halls. An open-air theatre with a seating capacity of 10,000 is located at the Manasagangotri campus.

Prasaranga and Printing Press

The University is maintaining its own printing press for all types of printing work. The Prasaranga is the publications division of the University which has published more than 1,500 books on various subjects, dictionaries, subject encyclopedias and monographs.

Radio Manasa 89.6 MHz

Radio Manasa was initiated at the University of Mysore in the year 2018 and started functioning in the year 2021 to stay connected with the community through various

programs in areas of education, health, culture, empowerment etc., thus bridging the gap of information to the community by their involvement in customising the programs to their needs.

Banking Services

The State Bank of India has two branches, one at the Manasagangotri Campus and the other at the Crawford Hall, which provides banking and ATM facilities to staff and students.

Cafeteria

University has a centrally located canteen at Manasagangotri campus which caters to the needs of students, research scholars and faculty.

Centre for Proficiency Development and Placement Services (CPDPS)

The University has established the Centre for Proficiency Development and Placement Services (CPDPS). The Centre offers programs for overall proficiency and personality development of the students. The centre also offers Functional English course for foreign students.

University Career Hub (UCH)

The University has recently established the Career Hub to promote training and placement for students and research scholars. It also houses incubation centre and entrepreneurship cell.

Employment, Information and Guidance Bureau

It is located in the University Library building at Manasagangotri to provide information on programs and career opportunities. Students can register their names for employment assistance at the Bureau.

Health Centre(s)

There are two Health Centers-one located at Maharaja's College campus and the other at the Manasagangotri campus of the University of Mysore, to take care of the medical needs of the students and faculty of the University.

Green Campus Inititatives

The Manasagangotri Campus has been declared as a 'Green Campus' and 'Swachha Campus'. The University is a leader in solarization of its campus providing power to street lamps and solar water heaters in all hostels. E-cart services have been introduced to reduce the pollution.

International Center

The International Center is located at the University College of Fine Arts at Manasagangotri. This is a single-window system facilitating the academic requirements of foreign students. It provides guidance and counseling to foreign students regarding admission to various programs in the University, besides assisting them in matters relating to eligibility, admissions, VISA, residential permits, bonafide certificates, etc. The Centre functions as liaison between students, academic institutions, faculty, university offices, diplomatic missions, government departments, police and other law enforcing agencies.

Internet Access

The entire Manasagangotri campus has wired and wireless internet browsing facilities. More details can be had from ICD (Information Communication Division), Department of Studies in Computer Science.

Library

The University Library located at the Manasagangotri campus has more than 12,50,000 collections of books, journals, bound volumes, theses, reports and manuscripts. The Library is kept open between 8 AM and 8 PM on all working days, through out the year, except on holidays. Departmental libraries are also available in most of the postgraduate departments.

Postal Services

India Post is running two Post Offices, one at the Manasagangotri campus and the other at Crawford Hall with savings/recurring deposits, telephone and Speed Post services.

Scholarships

The State and Central Governments have been awarding a number of scholarships to meritorious and deserving students, subject scholarships, endowment scholarships, sports scholarships, minority scholarships, single girl child scholarships and third gender scholarships are also available.

Special Cell for SC/ST students

There is a Special Cell to look after the welfare of SC/ST students. The cell also awards fellowships to students for carrying out research. Special coaching and brain storming classes are conducted for the benefit of SC/ST students appearing for competitive examinations. Training is also offered in computer skills. Bridge-courses are conducted

for promoting communication skills, writing and oratory skills. The Cell has a good library facility with books on general knowledge and computers. Financial assistance is also provided to students of the post-graduate departments through the directorate of social welfare.

Sports Facilities

Directorate of Physical Education looks after the sports activities. The University has sports fields, cricket stadium, tennis courts, gymnasium, indoor stadia and a swimming pool that cater to the needs of students and faculty. Sri Srikantadatta Narasimha Raja Wadeyar ground and three indoor stadiums are also located at Manasagangotri campus. The directorate encourages participation of the students in sports activities at University level Sports Competions and also at Zonal, National and International level sports events.

National Service Scheme (NSS)

University of Mysore was identified as the best University in the country in the field of National Service Scheme (NSS) and was awarded with 'Indira Gandhi National Award', from His Excellency Sri Pranab Mukherjee, Hon'ble President of India during November, 2016. The University has also secured 'State Award' by Government of Karnataka during May, 2017 for its contribution to NSS.

Student Welfare

Directorate of Student Welfare located at the EMRC building in Manasagangotri campus, looks after the student welfare programs in the University. The students are encouraged to participate in co-curricular activities, such as literary and cultural competitions, Inter-Collegiate and Inter-University competitions and Youth Festivals. It is a student-care unit as well as supervision centre, which serves as a bridge among the students and administrators.

Mysore University Day Care Centre

University of Mysore has started the Day Care Centre for the children especially of the University employees and students/employees of University who are in the age group of 6 months to 4 years. The main aim of this centre is to provide a challenging and stimulating environment for the child's optimal development under all faculties such as physical, motor, mental, social, emotional and personality, under the trained persons' custody especially when their parents are engaged in university services or pursuing their career or higher studies in University of Mysore.

Manasagangotri School

The Manasagangotri School is run by Manasagangotri Shikshana Samsthe with funding from the University of Mysore. The School started functioning from 1965. It was meant for the children of the Universities Staff aswell as the children of the neighbourhood. Vice Chancellor of the University of Mysore is the chief patron of this Institute. Classes are being conducted for the students of kindergarten upto SSLC. Nearly 350 students are studying here. The School has all the modern facilities required for the overall development of students. Well trained teachers take care of the curricular and co-curricular activities in a methodic manner, which in turn helps the pupils to have a clear understanding of the knowledge being imparted.

Centre for Education of Visually Challenged - DRUSHTEE

The University has taken up UPE holistic project 'Centre for Education of Visually Challenged- DRUSHTEE' to provide innovative teaching technique and philosophy that continues to have far-reaching effects on the lives of visually challenged students.

The Centre has established full fledged advanced computer lab in the University Library with assistive technologies for the education and training of visually impaired students, researchers and teachers of the University of Mysore. This is the first of its kind facility in the University system in the state of Karnataka.

Transport Services

Electric battery vehicle facilities are available within the Manasagangotri Campus for PG students and members of the teaching and administration staff.

Special Provisions for Admission

Supernumerary seats have been earmarked for all P.G. programs under Defence, Physically challenged, NSS, NCC, Literary and Cultural Activities, Sports, Children of University Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff, Third Gender, Destitute and Children of those farmers from Karnataka who have committed suicide under the pressure of debts.

Complaints Committee and Committee for Sensitization, Prevention and Redressal for Sexual Harassment (SPARSH)

The University has established Complaints Committee as per the directives of the Supreme Court and the UGC. The University has constituted an Apex Body of SPARSH to emphasize the commitment of the University to provide a workplace free of gender-based discrimination.

Anti-Ragging

The University has zero tolerance to ragging. Every student has to sign a declaration that he/she will not indulge in any form of ragging and other unlawful activities.

Hostel facilities for International Students

Exclusive hostel facilities are available for international students. The hostels feature independent rooms, space for study, internet connectivity, kitchenette facility, attached washrooms and enclosed chests for keeping belongings. Vishwamanava International Hostel houses two computer labs and a spacious dining hall cum kitchen complex. The International Guest House in Saraswathipuram, Mysore can house 50 students with all the amenities. Students pursuing one year Diploma/Certificate courses are not eligible for hostel facility.

Aadhar Registration

As per the instructions from the Government, all financial benefits to eligible students like reimbursement of examination/tuition fees, scholarships, etc., shall be transferred directly through bank, linked to AADHAR number. Students shall open a bank account and link this to their AADHAR number for availing such benefits. Details have to be provided in the application form. Those who do not have AADHAR number/bank account are encouraged to get AADHAR number and link it to their bank account.

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

Candidates applying for admission to Master's Degree / Postgraduate Diploma programs must be a graduate and must have obtained a minimum of 45% of marks and 40% in case of SC/ST/Category-I candidates in Cognate/Optional subjects wherever the Board of Studies of the respective Departments have not specified eligibility conditions. Details of the eligibility conditions are provided against the respective programs.

In case a candidate has taken longer than the prescribed duration to pass the qualifying program, a deduction of 3% of the aggregate marks of Cognate/Optional subjects for every additional year shall be made and the candidates must have obtained the minimum marks prescribed even after such deduction, to become eligible for admission.

Entrance Examination is Compulsory for all the Post Graduate Degree programs for all candidates except for foreign nationals. Candidates have to apply and appear for entrance examinations separately for each program. However, there shall be a single common entrance examination for the following groups of programs.

For all the remaining programs (not included in the above groups), candidates have to appear for each Entrance Examination. The candidates who seek admission for M.B.A., M.C.A., M.Tech.(CCT) and M.Tech. (CST) are advised to contact Karnataka Examination Authority (K.E.A.).

For admission to any PG degree program, candidates have to qualify in the respective entrance examination by securing a minimum 08 marks in case of SC/ST/ Cat-I candidates, 09 marks in case of OBC and 10 marks in case of other candidates out of 50 marks.

NOTE: The online application submitted by a candidate without qualifying the eligibility criteria for admission to a particular program, will not be considered, even if the candidate secures marks in the entrance examination.

- 1. N.S.S. Fee collected from students shall be allocated as follows: Out of Rs.50/-,(a) Rs.20/-may be retained in the College, (b) Rs.30/- to be remitted to the University for Joint Account No. 54007592645 at S.B.M., University Campus Branch, Mysuru-5.
- 2. Under the Scheme 'A' seats SC/ST students, whose Parent's annual income is Rs.2.50 Lakh and below (as per the Government order No. PE 80 ¥Pk 2013, Bangalore, dated 02.07.2013) the concerned Principals / Heads are requested to ascertain the latest additions if any with regard to any supplement orders at the time of filling/forwarding the application by the candidates for exemption of full fees (this category of students are enjoying the privileges of getting full fee concession) from the Social Welfare Department / Govt. of India. Further, for any reasons if the students fail to receive the benefit of the above, such students shall have to remit the prescribed fee in full.
- 3. For Cat-I and OBC students, whose annual income is below 2.5 lakhs and Rs.1.00 lakh respectively are exempted from payment of i) Tuition Fee, ii) Lab Fee iii) Sports Fee iv) Library Fee and v) Examination Fee out of whole Fee component, however, the head of the institution shall watch whether such students have applied for scholarship or not. If students who do not apply for any scholarships and also who do not receive scholarship from the Government will have to pay the full fee.
- 4. The Candidate who seeks seat under Scheme-B may also apply for scholarship if eligible. Further, the concerned shall watch whether the amount received towards scholarship is of full fee component or not. If, not such candidates shall be informed to pay the remaining balance of fee to the concerned account. Under Scheme-'B' SC/ST students whose parent's annual income is Rs. 2.50 Lakh and below have to pay the Administrative Fee applicable and 50% of the Tuition Fee for the Course. However, SC/ST/OBC/GM students whose parent's annual Income is above Rs. 2.50 Lakh, are given 2 installments for remitting the Tuition Fee. It shall be the responsibility of the concerned Principal to ensure that the further installments of fee are being collected promptly. In all such cases entries should be made in a separate Register maintained for the purpose which shall be produced at the time of auditing.

- 5. SC/ST students whose parents annual income is Rs. 2.5 lakhs to 10 lakhs (As per Government order no. PE178 YPk 2015, "AUMEGM dated 31.12.2015) are enjoying the privileges of getting 50% concession of the fees. However, the head of the institution shall watch whether such students have applied for scholarship or not. Further, for any reasons if the students fail to receive the benefit of the above, that such students shall have to remit the prescribed fee in full.
- 6. The NRI students are required to pay Tuition Fee on par with other foreign students. However, they shall pay the Eligibility Fee, wherever applicable, on par with non-karnataka students.
- 7. Tibetan refugees are treated on par with Indian students, and Tibetan refugees who have completed their studies in Karnataka are treated on par with Karnataka students.
- 8. Red Cross Fee collected from each student shall be allocated as follows: The fee amount Rs.50/-out of that amount (A) Rs.35/- retained in college for Red Cross activities (B) Rs.15/- has to be sent to the Indian Red Cross Society, Karnataka State Branch, No.26, Red Cross Bhavana, 1st Floor, Race Course Road, Bangaluru-560 001.
